Day	Scripture	Prayer Point
Day 5 - 9/14	Hebrews 11:16 And without faith it is impossible to please God, for he who comes to God must believe that He exists and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.	I declare that as I diligently seek God in secret, He rewards me publicly. I draw close to Him every day by spending time in His Word. As I draw near to listen, He draws near to me as He promised. I come to Him believing and revering Him for who He is and the great things He has done for me. I bring pleasure to God every day as I stop everything to spend time with Him, believing that He always meets me in those secret, quiet moments. His Word holds the universe together, and He still loves to meet with me. Amen.
Day 6 - 9/15	John 4:42 “They said to the woman, Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we have heard for ourselves and know that this Man is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world.”	I declare I no longer believe because of someone else’s testimony, as I now have my own testimonies of God’s faithfulness and good will at work in my life. I now hear Him myself, as faith grows by hearing His voice, and hearing Him grows from reading and knowing His Word. I know, Jesus Christ is undeniably the Savior of the world, and He died for me. Because of His sacrifice, I believe! Amen.
Day 7 – 9/16	Proverbs 14:30 A calm and undisturbed mind and heart are the life and health of the body, but envy, jealousy, and wrath are like rottenness of the bones.
